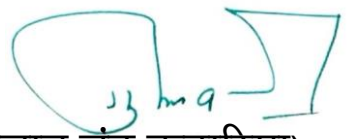

In 1900s, Rabindranath founded a school for children at Santiniketan and it was around this nucleus that the structure of an unconventional university, “Visva Bharati” (1921) developed through careful planning. “Visva-Bharati”, means ‘*the communion of the world with India*’. He believed that Visva-Bharati would connect India with the world in terms of culture. It was this utopian extension of the self that he attempted in his idea of Visva-Bharati in 1921, when Vidusekhar Shashtri read out its declaration:

“This is Visva-Bharati where the world makes its home in a single nest ... we are of the faith that Truth is one and undivided though diverse be the ways in which may lead us to it. Through separate paths pilgrims from different lands arrive at the same shrine of Truth.”

Rabindranath Tagore thought that Visva-Bharati, like other universities in the country, would not be bound by the syllabus; Outside all the regimes of the university, it will become a meeting place of omniscience freely. The curriculum he proposed for the students in the hope that the students would take charge of it in the future is consistent with his plan a few years ago: all Indian learning, such as Vedic mythology, Buddhism, Jainism, etc., should be practiced in a timely manner in Visva-Bharati. Education will be true and complete only if all other education is based on the education of our country. THIS ENCAPSULATES NEP IN ITS TRUE SPIRIT. PERHAPS WE NEED TO EMULATE THE SAME TOO.

Impact of AI in Higher Education and our role in it

Zuboff (2019) provides a good overview of the different areas in which AI is being applied in higher education and an indication of which areas researchers have tended to focus on. He identifies four key applications of AI in teaching and learning:

- profiling and prediction
- intelligent tutoring systems
- assessment and evaluation
- adaptive systems and personalisation

Artificial intelligence (AI) promises important benefits for education, such as personalised learning according to the preferences of each student, helping them learn at their own pace and control iterations to improve their knowledge on the topic. It is believed that one benefit of AI in the future will be its ability to “*assess students, provide feedback and generate and test scientific hypotheses at least as well as humans can*”.



Definition of artificial intelligence as it relates to higher education: *“Artificial intelligence is a binary machine with adaptive input, which resembles a rational person in the whole process of connecting with higher education. The binary origin of the fact that this intellect can be trained (for the benefit of learners) or a trainer (for the benefit of trainers). By a complete process related to higher education, we mean the process of teaching, learning and administrative services.”* (Janalta Interactive, p. 9 2021)

AI, Internet of Things (IoT), Machine Learning, Data Science, 3D Printing will keep evolving. Industry 4.0 compliant Education will move to 5.0 & so on. This is a continuous process.

But we need to see the larger purpose of life. Process of Education should lead to knowledge gathering, knowledge in turn will lead to wisdom. We just don't want a bunch of Technocrats with mechanical skills. There are essential pre-requisites, but it will not end itself. Journey of life wants self-discovery along with self-actualization and self-development.

Expectation & Responsibility

Today, all of you who are receiving your degrees are moving from the university's classrooms to become its much-cherished alumni. The students who are now studying here will henceforth look up to you as their inspiration. This is a feeling of great generosity as well as responsibility. This continuously evolving dialogue between a university's students – past and present – becomes, with the passage of years, the building blocks of the institution's rich heritage. As today's graduates, you are enhancing and enriching this remarkable dialogic process.

From tomorrow, your pathways to your chosen life-goals will take you in different directions. That is an inevitable principle of life. We move from one stage to another. But it is equally important to remember the significance of our roots without which we wouldn't be placed where we are now. Rabindranath Tagore University is that foundation in your journey forward as take the next step in your lives. The institution where we study is a source of immense pride. In the same way, your alma mater also takes great pride in you. You are the ones who bear the signature of this august institution.
